

# Archery



Anyone performing archery must dress appropriately. This means:

- Wear appropriate clothing for your session
- If your session is outdoor ensure you dress appropriately for that time of year
- **No** open toed shoes (sandals, crocs)
- Long hair must be tied back (bring your own hair tie/bobble)
- No loose hanging items (e.g. jewellery, tassels)
- Tight fitting clothes are good for archery as it prevents anything getting caught on the bow or arrow.
- Try to avoid any clothes with large buttons or anything that will catch on the bow string

Arm guards must be worn by all participants while shooting.

There are no toilet facilities near the archery range. Please remind Young People to visit the toilet facilities before your session time.

## Additional Needs

We are a fully inclusive activity and will do our best to accommodate any additional needs of a participant. However, it is extremely helpful if we are informed prior to the actual booking, of any participant that has additional needs. Please make sure you make us aware of any members of your group who may require additional support when making your booking and confirm on the actual day of your activity that the instructor is fully aware of anyone in your group with additional needs.

Instructors reserve the right to remove anyone (young person or adult) from the range who does not follow the safety instructions.

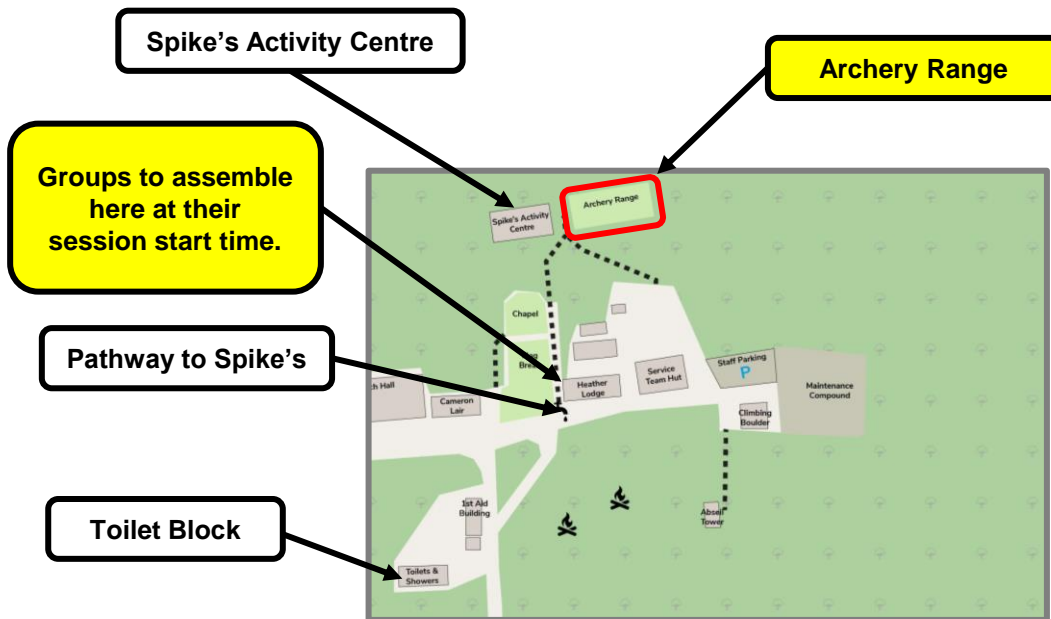

## Location on Site

Our archery range is located outside Spike's Activity Centre



## Additional measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19

The way we run our Archery sessions has been modified to allow us to run the activity in a fully socially distanced way. The following points must be adhered to by all participants and group leaders:



Maximum group size is 12 Participants + 1 Leader per 60 minute time-slot.



1 responsible adult to remain with the group during the session (responsible for any First Aid needs, toilet run, etc.)



Groups must arrive on-time for their session, and assemble in the waiting area (marked on the map above).



Instructors cannot offer close-contact support during a session. If a young person cannot perform archery safely, they may be requested to leave the activity. This means that we cannot currently offer archery to Beaver Scouts.



All participants must be COVID-19 symptom free. Instructors will verbally confirm this with the group at the waiting area.



Any young person who misbehaves will be removed from the activity and not allowed back.



A booking slot is 60 minutes. 45 mins for safety briefing and shooting, 15 minutes for the instructors to clean equipment and setup for the next group

We are currently not allowing adults to participate in archery.
